MC - We are looking at rotating the role of MC. A high level of kiting knowledge is required for this role. We are looking for MCs with knowledge in one or more of the following area's.

1. Single line kites including Fighter kite knowledge.
2. Sport Kite Experience with current knowledge of the latest tricks and manoevers.
3. Kite Buggies
4. Kite Boarding

Judges - With Single line and sport kite experience. We require a couple of kiteflyers who could assist in coordinating the events.

Kiteflyers assistant – Assist registration packs, lunches & dinners etc.

Field Setup and Sponsor Banners - Thurs afternoon. Assistance required with field setup.
Field Pack Down - Monday after 4 pm.

Lolly Drops - Lollies have been donated by our sponsors. Lollies will be ready to go with Parachutes attached. We need a couple of kite flyers prepared to be responsible to run 5 – 10 or so drops on each day.

Teddy Drops - An activity that is always popular with the spectators. Kite flyers required to coordinate with the MC.

Rokkaku Challenge *this is a Compulsory Event*, we do need kite flyers to support this event. All participants receiving a Festival pack is registered to enter. It is designed as a good show for the sponsors & spectators. Not a serious competition for kite flyers. Good sportsmanship is required, and kite flyers who understand the purpose of a quick, fast, showmanship challenge that is a highlight for the festival.

Single Line Competitions (Competitions will only go ahead if competitors are prepared to assist in running them) and Demonstrations:

The Hargrave Trophy (Open) - Based on originality of kite design, kite graphics, kite performance

Popular Kite – Being judge by the kiting group.
